Guidance for SU Officers and Representatives

- We encourage you to promote the elections, but please don't promote or endorse some candidates over others. Instead, encourage all students to nominate and vote using www.warwicksu.com/elections
- In the same way, candidates cannot claim the support of any SU representative
- If you are re-running, you cannot use the resources and facilities that would be available to you due to your position to promote your campaign.

Guidance for Staff members

- We encourage you to promote the elections, but please don't promote or endorse some candidates over others. Instead, encourage all students to nominate and vote using www.warwicksu.com/elections
- In the same way, candidates cannot claim the support of any staff member
- If you are a candidate and are SU staff, you cannot use the resources available to you through that position to promote your campaign

Guidance for Clubs and Societies

- We encourage you to promote the elections, but please don't promote or endorse some candidates over others.



- Clubs and Societies, and Club and Society Exec members are not allowed to endorse particular candidates on social media or in person. You can support a friend in a personal capacity but never in relation to your position. Instead, encourage all students to nominate and vote using www.warwicksu.com/elections
- In the same way, candidates cannot claim the support of any SU club or society, or SU club or society exec member.
